### Academic results – 2015

Forty-five students achieved an ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank) of 90 or more, placing them in the 10 percent of students in Australia ♦ Nine of the Top 20 Northern Territory students were from Darwin High School, including the top NT student who achieved an ATAR of 99.90 ♦ Ninety-eight percent of our students completed their NTCET and over half of graduating students achieved an ATAR of 70 or above, placing them in the top 30 percent of students in Australia.

### Pathways to university

Students who study at Darwin High School can complete Year 12 and achieve an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR), which can lead to further study at Australian universities.
