Supported Devices:

- Standard Windows 7/8/10 laptops
- Apple Mac laptops

Recommended Hardware:

- Intel i3 or equivalent
- 120GB Solid state hard drive
- 4GB RAM
- 4+ hrs of battery life

Higher specs will be required to run Adobe and Autodesk software.

*Unfortunately some devices are limited to their capability; network access is not always guaranteed to work on all laptops/tablets. Devices are recommended to have at least 802.11n dual band (Wireless N) networking.

Software

Students will have access to a range of software they can use while attending Darwin High School. These include but are not limited to:

- Microsoft Office 365 – Available to download for student devices from <http://portal.microsoftonline.com> using Ntschools email account. This includes Word, Excel, Publisher, Powerpoint etc. OneDrive is also accessible for students to store files online. Please note that some Office programs are not available for Mac.
- ClickView Online – Students are able to watch a range of multimedia set by teachers from home or at school using their Ntschools account. <http://online.clickview.com.au/>
- Efofex Science Pack – FX Chem, FX ChemStruct and FX Equation. Registration code available from IT Services.
