



The recommended specifications and device types suitable for use in the school environment are:

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### → Software

- Students will have access to a range of software that they can use while attending Darwin High School. These include but are not limited to:
- Microsoft Office 365 - Available from <http://portal.microsoftonline.com> with an ntschools.net student account.
- Microsoft Office Suite – Available to download for student devices from <http://portal.microsoftonline.com>, This includes the entire Office Suite as well as OneDrive to allow students to save documents online so they have access to files at home or at school.
- ClickView Online – Students are able to watch a range of multimedia set by teachers from Home or at school with an ntschools.net student account – <http://clickview.darwinhigh.nt.edu.au>
- Efofex Science Pack – FX Chem, FX ChemStruct and FX Equation (Windows only)
- Efofex Maths Pack - FX Draw, FX Equation, FX Graph and FX Stat (Windows only)
- PaperCut – When configured correctly students should be able to print via PaperCut to their accounts. This is limited to standard Windows and Apple Mac Laptops. Please see DHS IT Services at recess or lunch if you need help setting this up.

### → Hardware

Recommended Devices:

- Unfortunately some devices are limited in their capability; network access is not always guaranteed to work on all laptops/tablets. Devices are recommended to have at least 802.11n dual band (Wireless N) networking.
- Standard Windows 7/8/8.1 Laptops/Tablets (e.g. Surface Pro1 /2/3 & Traditional Windows Laptops) with at least 4 to 6 hours battery life.
- Apple Mac Laptops (Air/Pro etc.) with at least 4 to 6 hours battery life.

Alternative Devices:

- Apple iPad with Bluetooth key board – students will have access to Microsoft Suite on their iPads and OneDrive for Storage.
