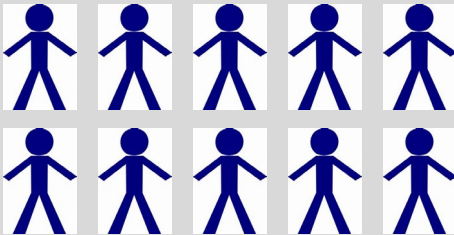


The Board has 19 members:

The board meets once a month (during term times).

7 subcommittees support the board.

DHS Board duties include:

- advising the Principal about the educational needs of the community and policy implementation;
- endorsing and overseeing implementation of the school business plan and on-flowing strategic implementation plans and reporting;
- assessing and advising on the physical needs of the school;
- building links between parents, community groups and the school;
- determining the school's annual budget;
- determining community use of school facilities.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander (ATSI) Advisory Committee

Responsible for:

- Providing strategic advice to the Board on matters affecting ATSI students.
- Developing strategies to ensure ATSI students can fully participate in the school community and achieve their full potential.



Buildings and Master Plan Committee

Responsible for:

- The continued development of the Darwin High School Master Plan
- Making recommendations to the Board on prioritisation and staging of Master Plan
- Holding representation on the Bullocky Point Education Precinct Committee.



Finance Committee

Responsible for:

- Oversight of the global school budget, the Board budget and the schools monthly finance reports.
- Making recommendations to the Board based on the above budgets and reports.
- Considering strategic issues relating to the financial management of the school referred by the Principal or the Board.



Governance Committee

Responsible for:

- Oversight of Board member duties, obligations and training needs.
- Oversight of Board governance documents such as the Board Charter, Constitution and Guidelines.
- Oversight of the statutory reporting obligations of the Board.
- Oversight of a school risk management framework.
- Reviewing Board effectiveness and recommending strategies for its improvement.



International Education Committee

Responsible for:

- Developing an international and intra-Territory student presence at Darwin High School.
- Enhancing cultural diversity and encouraging all students to develop an international perspective.
- Providing strategic advice to successfully integrate international students into the school community.
- Enhancing the school's international education agenda through identifying international partnerships with other schools and organisations.



Policy and Performance Committee

Responsible for:

- Oversight of the continuous improvement framework of the school.
- Providing advice to the Board on how the school is tracking towards its targets as detailed in the Strategic Plan and Annual Improvement Plan.



Wellbeing Committee

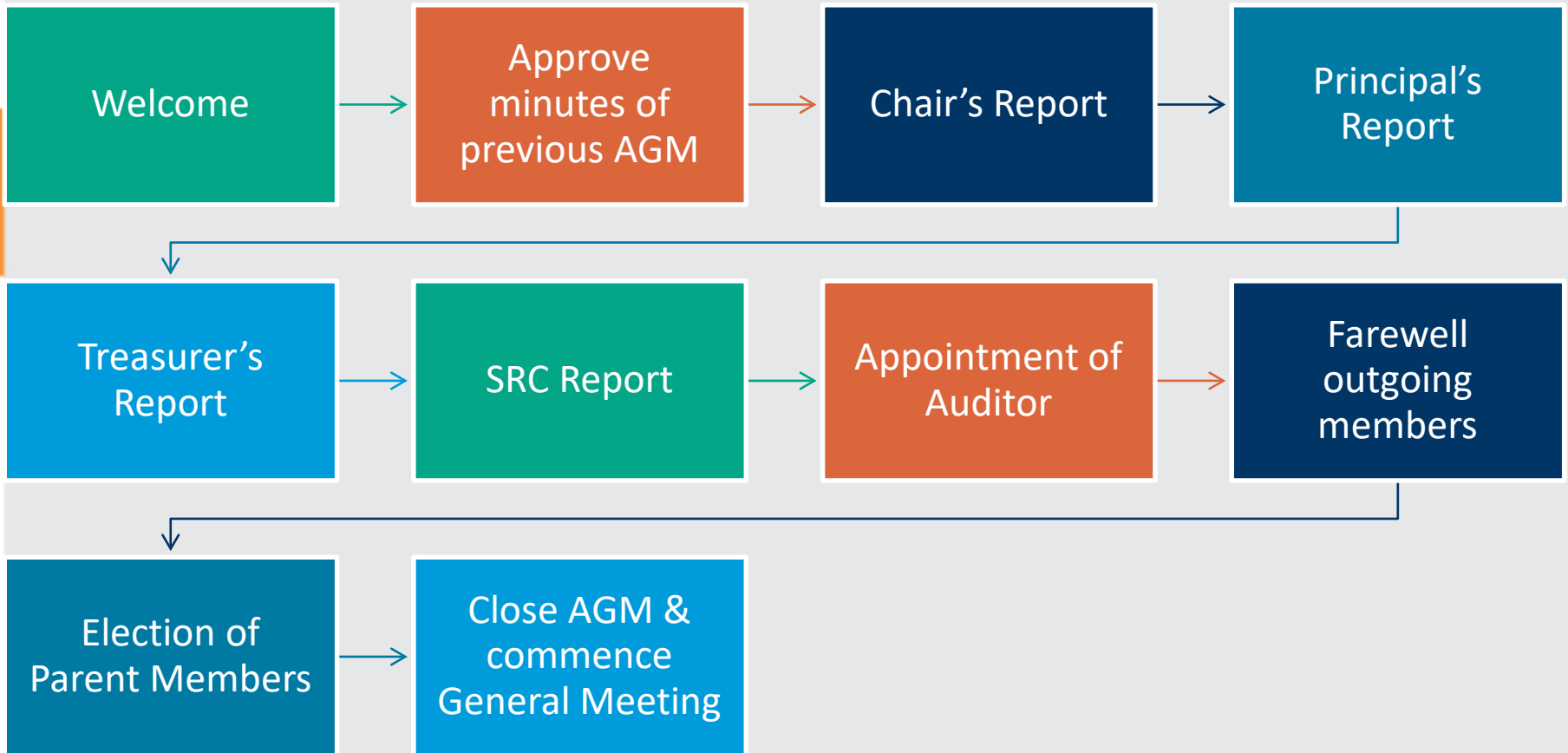
Responsible for:
