

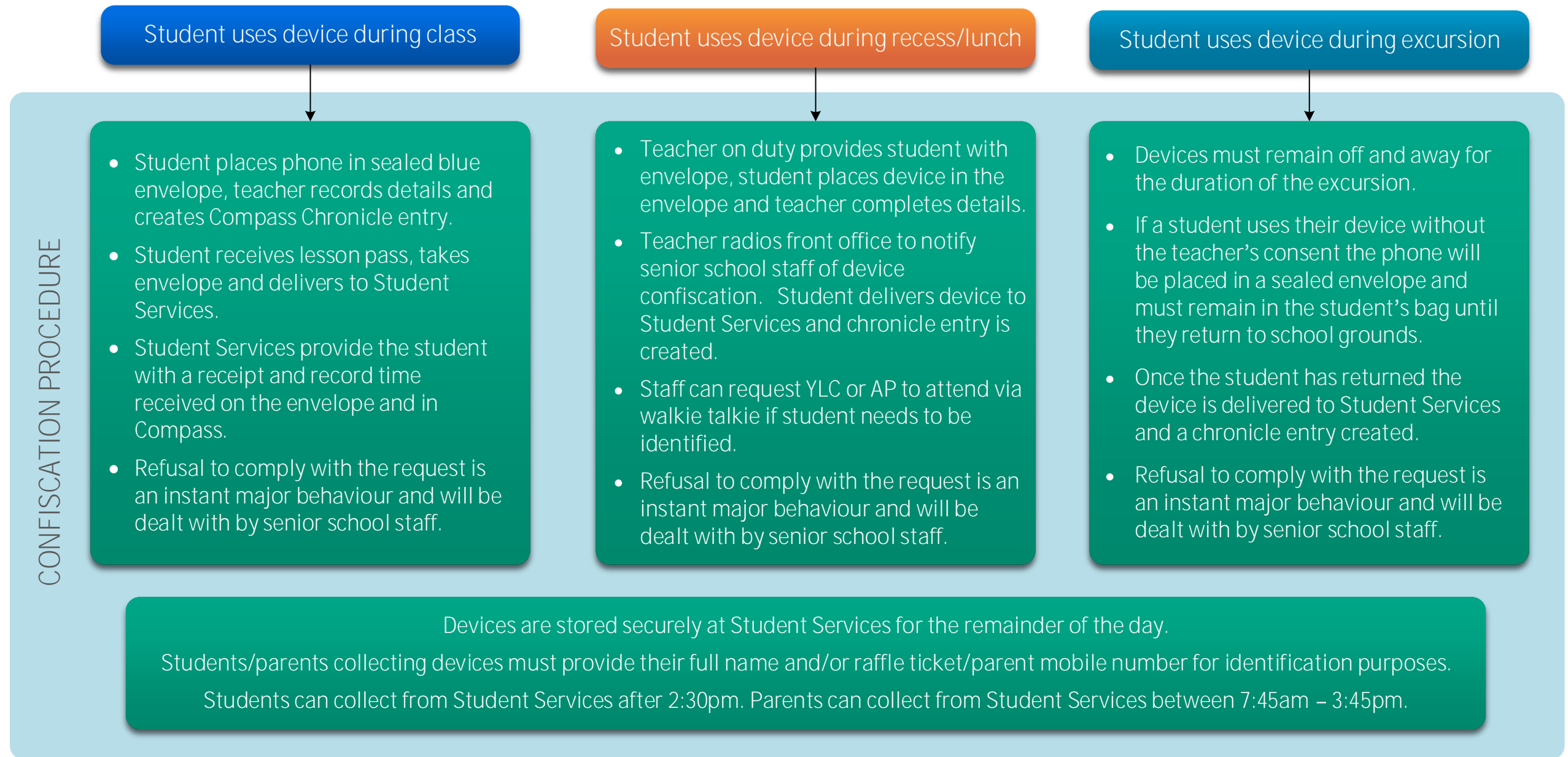
MANAGEMENT OF STUDENT MOBILE PHONES – CONFISCATION PROCEDURE

The purpose of this document is to outline Darwin High School’s procedure for the confiscation of student mobile devices.

For more information please refer to the school’s *Management of student mobile phones and electronic devices policy and procedures*.

Key points:

- Students are only permitted to use their devices under the direct instruction of a teacher or staff member.
- If students need to contact their parents/ carers there is a phone available at Student Services. Parents/ carers can contact their child via the school.
- Students are not permitted to use their devices for Compass or to make payments (incl. canteen and Student Services).



CONSEQUENCES

First breach

Phone is confiscated for the remainder of the day. Student collects device from Student Services after final bell.

Second breach

Phone is confiscated for the remainder of the day. Parent receives notification via Compass and parent required to collect the device.

Third breach

Banned from bringing device to school for four weeks. Students who bring their device during the four week period risk suspension.
