Rules for undertaking SACE Board assessments under direct supervision

Rules For Undertaking Tests and Exams

Any infringement of the following conditions is considered a breach of the rules.

You must not, during an assessment, including a test or an exam:

- have in your possession any book or notes (apart from the materials permitted for that test, assignment, or examination), or any other means that would improperly help you in your work;
- have in your possession **ANY** electronic device (including mobile phones, electronic dictionaries, MP3 players and other media storage devices) apart from calculators (where permitted);
- directly or indirectly help any other student;
- permit any other student to copy from or otherwise use your papers;
- directly or indirectly accept help from any other student;
- use any papers of any other student;
- by any other improper means whatever, obtain or try to obtain, directly or indirectly, help in your work, or help or try to help, directly or indirectly, any other student;
- collude with another student to take your place in an assessment (e.g. an examination);
- be guilty of any breach of good order or propriety.

BREACH OF RULES

An infringement of any of the rules or conditions listed above is a breach of the rules, and penalties may apply. Your marks for an assessment task, an assessment component, or a subject may be cancelled or amended, as determined by the SACE Board. If you are in breach of the rules in an external examination, you will have your marks for the examination cancelled or amended, and be liable to such further penalty, whether by exclusion from future examinations or otherwise, as the SACE Board determines

In the Exam Room

- Opaque pencil cases will not be permitted. Bring pens, pencils in a clear plastic zip lock bag if necessary.
- Mobile phones and other electronic storage devices are not permitted on your person or in your possession.
- Calculators may only be used in the following subjects:
Any Maths subject, Accounting Studies, Biology, Chemistry, IT Studies, Nutrition, PE, Physics and Psychology
- Calculators need to be approved and will have their memory cleared in all of the above subjects EXCEPT for Mathematics subjects.
- Calculator covers are not permitted in the exam room.
- Electronic dictionaries are not permitted. Approved bi-lingual dictionaries may be used, but will be checked.
- You will not be able to leave the exam prior to the finishing time.
- There will be 10 minutes reading time for each exam. During that time you may not mark the exam paper in any way, or use a calculator.
- Food and drink, apart from water, are not permitted in the exam room.
- Use blue or black pen in exams except for drawings etc where you should use a HB pencil.
- Bring spare pencils, pens and batteries for your calculator!
